MORPHINE sulfate **200 mg TID**OXYCODONE 5 mg/ 325 mg acetaminophen QID
GABAPENTIN 600 MG QPM
CYCLOBENZAPRINE 10 MG TID
LIDOCAINE 5% OINTMENT
LORAZEPAM 0.5 mg QD
PSEUDOEPHEDRINE 60 TID

"I'm getting a new PCP and hope that this new PCP will increase my pain meds instead of decreasing them further".

PSYCHIATRIC HISTORY

- Polysubstance dependence/abuse (IV heroin, methadone, alcohol and cocaine dependence /abuse)
- Suicidal ideation and overdoses
- Multiple incarcerations
- Multiple shooters abscesses from heroin injecting
- Eloped with central line in place (1998)
- Methadone maintenance
- Multiple admissions for IV drug use / cutaneous abscesses
- Major Depression
- Insomnia
- Impaired cognition / Memory loss
- Abusive/Violent/Priority/Crisis CWAD

Medical Issues

- Constipation and Difficulty Voiding
- Insomnia and disturbed sleep
- COPD/smoking
- OSA
- Frequent Falls/Ataxia
